


**Figure 1:** General Allenby's march into the Russian Compound in Jerusalem, 1917. Wikimedia Commons.




**Figure 2**: Palestine Police Emblem, which appeared on official documents, caps, and even cuff links. Wikimedia Commons.


**Figure 4:** Example of a Zimox-classified fingerprint and Identification Magazine, Vol 6, No. 11. (May 1925):32.




The bomb, showing alarm clock attachment



Impressions of left four fingers of accused


